While our levee banks provide protection, we know they can be tested by major events.

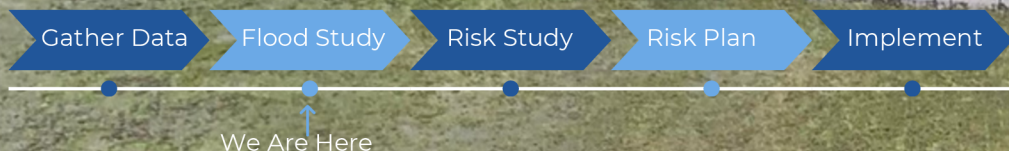
This Study combines technical modelling with local knowledge to guide land use planning, infrastructure design, emergency management and community resilience.
