The Toyota Tour de OROC run by the Rotary Club of Dubbo South, is a challenging 6-day biennial bicycle ride created to raise funds for the Macquarie Homestay.

The Macquarie Home Stay is your home away from home when you need to come to Dubbo to seek medical treatment at Dubbo Hospital. Established by a group of community members who saw the need for low cost but not low quality, affordable accommodation to be provided, it ensures the cost of accommodation is not a hindrance to seeking treatment when you have to attend Dubbo Hospital. Macquarie Home Stay has been established for one purpose - to provide patients and their partner or carer with accommodation while preparing for or post treatment at Dubbo Hospital.

Funds raised by this years Tour de OROC will go towards the development of Stage Three, which includes much needed family accommodation at Macquarie Home Stay. These funds also help demonstrate to government funding bodies that this is a critical asset for the people of the Orana Region – one that is strongly supported by the local community.
