When you submit this form, the information you provide on it is being collected and held by Warren Shire Council, 115 Dubbo Street, Warren, to assess your eligibility to receive a pensioner concession regarding the payment of charges and/or rates under the *Local Government Act 1993* (NSW) (**LG Act**) and associated regulations.

The information provided on this form is private and confidential. Council will not disclose the information to any person or body if it is not directly related to the purpose for which the information was collected, unless disclosure is required under a relevant law. The supply of your information is voluntary, but if you choose not to provide information requested on this form and evidence that you meet the definition of an 'eligible pensioner' under the LG Act and associated regulations (see below), it may affect the outcome of your application for a pensioner concession.

Consent to obtain evidence to assess your application for a pensioner concession

To assist Warren Shire Council with assessing your eligibility for a pensioner concession, it seeks your consent to use Centrelink Confirmation eServices to perform a Centrelink and/or Department of Veterans' Affairs (DVA) enquiry, and obtain its results, regarding your Centrelink or DVA customer details and concession card status. Your details may be checked regularly, to confirm ongoing eligibility. At any time, you have a right to withdraw your consent by contacting Warren Shire Council or Services Australia.

- Warren Shire Council to use Centrelink Confirmation eServices to perform a Centrelink/DVA enquiry of my Centrelink or DVA customer details and concession card status to enable Warren Shire Council to determine if I qualify for a pensioner concession.

I understand that:

I can get proof of my circumstances or details from Services Australia or DVA and provide it to Warren Shire Council so they, Warren Shire Council, can determine my eligibility for a pensioner concession.

Additional Information

Council will determine your eligibility to receive a pensioner concession of up to \$250 off your annual rates and/or charges. You may also be eligible to receive up to \$87.50 on your annual water charges and up to \$87.50 off your annual sewerage charges, if Council provides these services. Alternatively, if Council does not provide these services, contact your water/sewer service provider for more information.

Eligibility:

- Holders of the PCC (Pensioner Concession Card)*;
- Holders of the DVA Veteran Gold Card embossed 'TPI' (Totally & Permanently Incapacitated);
- Holders of the DVA Veteran Gold Card embossed 'EDA' (Extreme Disablement Adjustment).

Holders of cards other than those listed above are not eligible for the concession.

* If you are a War Widow or Widower or Wholly Dependent Partner and do not have a Pensioner Concession Card, you could contact the DVA to test your eligibility for the DVA [Income Support Supplement](#) which attracts a PCC.
